

Stock Market Game Due Date – **Feb. 16, 2018**

Students can play the game with a partner. **You will turn in and be graded on the stock market form.**

You will have \$5,000 with your partner. You will check the newspapers every Wednesday to record and monitor your stocks. Every Wednesday you will have to record Tuesday's closing price of your stock from Wednesday's newspaper on your record sheet for that week. At the end of 6 weeks you and your partner will turn in your sheet with totals. The winners in every class with the most money will receive 10 extra credit points. You can buy up to 8 of the following company's stocks and you have to buy at least 3. In real life you can buy and trade constantly, but you can not for this game. You need to use as close to \$5,000 as you can. You lose what you don't spend. There is a separate sheet to be turned in after the 6th week check. You will earn a grade with your partner. The first 2 columns are 5 points each and every other column is 10 points for a total of 100 points possible.

Use the following stocks for the game. We are only using these stocks, I know there are hundreds more and in real life you can buy and trade any of them at any time, but this game is to give you a taste of the stock market not a full blown stock market class. We are practicing with the more common stock you may know that are listed in the *Peoria Journal Star (PJS)*. Locate the **Last** column to find the closing price.

Here are stocks to choose from in Wed., Jan. 10, 2018, P.J. Star. They are Tues., the 9th's closing prices.
